PHOTOGRAPH COLLECTIONS

Feilding Agricultural High School

The Old Pupils' Association of the local high school has donated much of the history of the school that opened in 1922. The first principal, L J Wild, wrote many published agricultural articles. His vision was to encourage farming families to send their children to board at the school hostel. He instigated a model farm so pupils as part of an educational programme to equip students with practical skills and techniques for agricultural endeavour.

During WW2 he personally wrote to every ex-pupil who was a serviceman. The replies he received from overseas were read out at morning assembly.

The large photographic collection includes, pupils, teachers, school events, clubs and organizations, farming and sports from 1922 onwards.

Feilding Library

The local library has digitized many photographs in their collection. These are viewable on 'Heritage Collection' on the library website. The originals are stored at FDCA for safe keeping.

Feilding Herald

When the office of this community newspaper closed in 2017 the archive was invited to collect the collection of photographs and negatives ranging from the 1960s to 2016. It includes community events, functions, people profiles, sport and club news. The collection is not easily searchable. The photographs are sorted into subject titles.

Paul Legg

Paul Legg worked as a professional photographer based in Feilding in the 1970s. The Paul Legg photograph collection is housed in several series –

negatives, aerial farm photographs and unsorted material. The collection originates from Feilding Public Library and Paul Legg. On his retirement to Picton, Paul when moving to a rest home, gave much of his photographic career's photographs to the archive. He included an electronic catalogue which has helped with identification of some photographs.

TEXTILES

The textile collection consists of underwear and embroidered clothing such as baby wear, tablecloths, household items, bed linen, horse riding gear and hats. A few historic costumes are included.
